Tragically, as United Nations Secretary General Antonio Guterres has observed, anti-Semitism "is on the rise in all parts of the world."

OUR RECOGNITION

Today, anti-Semitism comes not only from Holocaust deniers and bigots, but from organized political groups and individuals who attempt to demonize, delegitimize, and apply a double standard to Israel, the most vibrant democracy in the Middle East.
