The intern will work out of the AZM office in Midtown Manhattan, a short distance from Grand Central Terminal. The weekly hours of the internship are flexible subject to the intern's availability. The intern will either be paid or receive course credit.

The intern's responsibilities will include but are not limited to assisting AZM staff with:

- AZM website and database development
- Social media
- Graphic design
- Organizing AZM's float and group at the Israel Parade
- Working with a task force to pursue its goals
- Brainstorming and executing Zionist education initiatives
- Youth and student engagement
- Organizing programming such as speakers and gatherings
- Board and committee meetings
- Outreach to board members and other stakeholders
- Development/fundraising
- Organizing AZM's existing files
- Updating press and organizational contacts

The intern will benefit from mentorship from AZM staff and lay leadership.
